

Privacy & Data Protection Statement

Scope

This Privacy & Data Protection Statement informs users about the type, extent and purpose of the collection and use of personal data by the responsible operator FONG'S EUROPE GMBH, Milchgrundstrasse 32, D-74523 Schwäbisch Hall, Hesselal, Germany, Phone: +49 (0)791 403 0, Fax: +49 (0)791 403 166, E-mail: info@fongs.eu on this website (hereinafter "service") auf.

The legal bases for data protection are to be found in the German Data Protection Act (BDSG) and the Telemedia Act (TMG).

Access data / Server log files

The operator (or its web space provider as applicable) collects data each time the service is accessed (so-called server log files). Amongst others, access data includes:

Name of the website accessed, file, date and time of access, volume of data transmitted, notification whether access was successful, browser type including version, the user's operating system, referrer URL (website previously visited), IP address and the provider making the inquiry.

This log data is used for purposes of statistical analysis, operational purposes, security and optimisation of content on offer. In the event specific indicia result in a legitimate suspicion of unlawful use, the operator reserves the right to conduct a subsequent verification of such data.

Handling of personal data

Personal data is information that helps to identify a person, i.e. information that can be traced back to a person. This includes, for example, name, e-mail address or telephone number. However, personal data also include data about which websites a person visits. The operator only collects, uses and discloses personal data if this is legally permitted or the user has consented to the collection of such data.

Contact

When contacting the operator (for example via the contact form or e-mail), user data will be stored for the purpose of inquiry processing as well as in case of follow-up questions.

Integration of third-party services and contents

Third-party content, such as YouTube videos, maps by Google Maps or graphics from other websites, may be integrated into this online service. This always requires the providers of these contents to use the user's IP address, as this is essential for them to send the contents to the respective user's browser. It is therefore necessary to transmit the IP address in order to display these contents. We do our best to use only contents whose respective providers use the IP address merely for the purpose of content delivery. However, we cannot influence whether or not third-party providers store the IP address, for example for statistical purposes. We will inform users of this to the extent we have information available.

Cookies

Cookies are small files that enable specific, device-related information regarding the users' access device (PC, smartphone etc.) to be stored. On the one hand, they improve the user-friendliness of websites and thus help users (e.g. storage of login details), on the other hand, they help to collect the statistical data of website usage and their analysis for the purpose of optimisation of content on offer. You as a user can influence the use of cookies. Most browsers have an option to limit or completely prevent the storage of cookies. However, this may result in a restriction of the use and in particular the user convenience of the service.

Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files placed on the users' computer, to help the website analyse how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about the use of the website by users (including the IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States.

In case of the activation of IP-anonymisation on this website, Google will shorten the user IP-address within member states of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Treaty on the European Economic Area (EEA) who do not belong to the European Union. Only in exceptional cases will the complete IP address be transferred to a server of Google in the US, where it will be shortened. This website's IP-anonymisation is active. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating the use of the website by users, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage.

Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. You may also prevent the collection of data produced by the cookie related to your use of the website (including your IP address) by Google and the processing of such information by Google by downloading and installing the following browser-plug-in through the following link: <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=de>.
